



SHARED ACCOMMODATION

Shared accommodation is an increasingly **popular way of living**. It has **many advantages**:

- **Accommodation with friends, siblings or as a couple.**
- **Larger and cheaper: shared accommodation** lets you benefit from **larger, more comfortable accommodation**, while paying a **moderate rent**, since it is **shared between two tenants**.
- **Shared costs:** flatmates not only share the rent, they also share costs: expenses, shopping, etc., which is an economic advantage.
- **Sharing a flat** also means **sharing good times, exchanging** ideas and being surrounded by people.

Crous de Bordeaux offers T5 accommodation in Pessac/Talence for a maximum of 4 students and T4 accommodation in Pau for a maximum of 3 students **in shared flats**.

For this type of accommodation, you cannot choose your flatmates.

Crous de Bordeaux also offers T1Bis, T2 and T3 apartments for rent, which can be occupied by a maximum of two people, with a **choice of** shared accommodation:

TYPE OF ACCOMMODATION	TYPE OF OCCUPANCY
T1 Bis: one room	single, couple's room, double room
T2: living room + 1 bedroom	single, couple's room, double room
T3: living room + 2 bedrooms	for two flatmates <u>as priority</u>



Priority given to requests for two student flatmates.

NOTE: If you are applying for a flat share for this type of accommodation, it is up to you to find your flatmate, not Crous.

SHARED ACCOMMODATION

How do I get a shared flat for 2021/2022?

Accommodation is allocated to **students enrolled in a master's or doctoral programme in a higher education establishment in Aquitaine, recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation.**

These Crous accommodation units entitle you to [housing subsidies](#) (CAF) and to the [Visale joint guarantee](#): www.visale.fr

The procedure for applying for shared accommodation is the same as for any other type of accommodation in a Crous residence:

- **As of 09 July 2021, you can apply for accommodation by logging on to trouverunlogement.lescrous.fr.**
- **For shared accommodation:** you and your flatmate must each send an **email to the Pôle Logement (Housing Unit)** (logement.international@crous-bordeaux.fr) mentioning the **surname/first name/INE** of the person with whom you wish to share.

You have been allocated accommodation:

- You will receive an SMS and an email with a link to **make the online payment via Cité'U**. To access it, log on to your Espace Crous: www.messervices.etudiant.gouv.fr, 'Gérer mon logement' (Manage my accommodation) section.
- **You must pay the accommodation reservation fee (€100) before the expiry date indicated** in the allocation email. If you do not meet the reservation deadline, you will lose this offer and the accommodation will be offered to another student waiting for accommodation.
- You must send the **completed rental application within 7 working days to the allocated residence**, otherwise the allocation will be cancelled.
- You have **7 days from the date of arrival on the allocation notification to take possession of the premises**, failing which the allocation will be cancelled.

You have not been allocated accommodation:

- If you are still looking for accommodation in Aquitaine: from 09 July 2021, you will be able to consult the accommodation offers still available after the social tour in the **'Trouver un logement en résidence Crous' (Find accommodation in a Crous residence)** space and apply for one of the accommodations on offer. Crous de Bordeaux will make the allocations according to the availability of accommodation. If you are offered accommodation, you will be informed by email and SMS.
- If you are looking for accommodation in another academy, consult the relevant Crous website to find out what steps to take.
- You and your flatmate must each send an **email to the Pôle Logement (Housing Unit)** (logement.international@crous-bordeaux.fr) mentioning the **surname/first name/INE** of the person with whom you wish to share.
